What they say:

"The final overall design reflects the feel we wanted to achieve but there were some changes from the initial design along the way. We had chosen a stone slab counter top with a glass undermounted sink for the master ensuite but this was replaced with a Corian top with integrated sink. That was rolled out across all the bathrooms by the developer."

Project cost: £2,500 for sanitaryware and brassware ex Vat

The brief:

Due to the location of this development it was imperative to achieve a high-end sophisticated design that would appeal to the local market. Highbury Park is quite a leafy area and the designers felt that although the properties were contemporary, they wanted to incorporate some natural stone which would soften the overall design. The bath is by Kaldewei and the furniture includes a bespoke corian countertop with integrated basin.
